### Project Idea

**Reason for application** Honors Carolina is in need of a browser based tool that would give Honors Students an easy way to sort through a large amount of files stored in various locations to find the ones relevant to them. The initial use case would be a Resume Database, but this could grow to any type of document or file.

One of the challenges for Honors Carolina has is that it is a diverse population of 2000 students across all majors, colleges and interests. So the idea of a resume template is a disservice to them as it is too generic to be of use beyond a starting point. However individual students by working with Professional Development Coaches have specialized and individual resumes that highlight their specific industry, skills and interests. The idea that future Honors Students could get inspiration from previous classes is far more powerful than any individual resume guide or template. An individual could find the format from one resume, a research section structure from another and how to list awards from yet another. This combination of inspiration would help them present themselves in their words more than making their skills fit someone else's mold.

While the content itself exists, the challenge is how does an individual student find the samples relevant to them. This is where the tool would come into play. The idea is the tool is simply a tagging and filtering interface for existing databases, like a centralized router. The files could be stored anywhere where a hyperlink would grant access (Dropbox, Google Drive, Microsoft Shared Folders, AWS, etc.). The portal would give administrators (Honors Carolina Staff) the ability to add approved files to the listing and add a number of Tags to each file. For example a single resume may have the following Tags "Resume", "Classof2024", "Physics", "Python", "Research." Honors Students and Staff would then have the ability to search for files by Tag, for example "Resume", "Physics" in which case they would get a list of all files that meet their required filters. They would then be a single click away from accessing that file regardless where it was stored.

**CS - Current Solution** Today we use a traditional resume guide and through coaching giving individual reviews, advice and inspiration.
