Reason for application	The department needs a straightforward online training that all its LAs can take before starting service, regardless of whether they're able to enroll in COMP 227.
CS - Current Solution	With a brief orientation workshop (on hold since COVID) and professors' case-by-case efforts. This leads to a lack of consistency in the content and level of CS LAs' training on both pedagogy and policy.
CS - Who are users?	LAs in the CS department--and, if our efforts are successful, potentially in other departments, which would contribute to campus-wide efforts to standardize and improve UNC's use of LAs.
CS - Software Access Point	Web browser (desktop); Web browser (mobile); Not sure
Other Access Point	
CS - Additional Constraints	I would definitely want the training to be accessible via desktop browser and responsive to mobile at the very least. It'd be wonderful to offer native apps, but the priority is to make the training available to the greatest possible number of UNC users on the greatest possible number of different devices that we can manage.
CS - Concerns with student ownership?	No, I do not have concerns.
CS - Describe Concerns	
CS - Protected health information?	No health information, but we might want to store information about who had completed the training and who had not.
Additional information	I can bring the materials and pedagogy and UI design. But I'm also open to letting the students try their hand at the UI or to introduce them to UI and instructional principles (informally) as part of the process if the interest is there (but that's optional). Finally, I'd welcome students' input into what they wish they'd known/done as LAs or wish the LAs in their classes had known/done so we can build the best training possible.
